Tax Payer Identification Number (TIN) Matching Update With the launch of the electronic Vendor Portal (eVP) upgrade, the new TIN Matching tool is already having a large impact. NC eVP Public Vendor Search The Public Vendor Search is a tool that can be used to search for Vendors who are registered in the NC electronic Vendor Portal. This tool provides a way to search for Vendors by name, federal tax ID number, location, registered commodity codes, construction codes, and more. Search results provide detailed information about the Vendor including what services the Vendor subscribes to, such as NC E-Procurement, eQuote, and/or the Interactive Purchasing System (IPS).

Follow the instructions below to determine whether or not a Vendor is actively registered for a particular service.

1. Access the **Public Vendor Search** page at <https://vendor.ncgov.com/vendor/public-vendor-search>.
2. Search for a Vendor by name, federal tax ID number, or by using the search filters.
3. From the **Search Results** page, view the columns titled “NC E-Procurement,” “eQuote,” “IPS,” and “HUB.” If a check mark appears, the Vendor has an active registration in that system.
