

The New eVP Updates

April 2023

The new electronic Vendor Portal (eVP) will improve user experience for buyers by combining functionality in the current electronic Vendor Portal (eVP), the Interactive Purchasing System (IPS), and the NC Business Invitation Delivery System (NC BIDS).

NEW eVP ENHANCEMENTS

The new eVP will introduce the use of 6-digit United Nations Standard Products and Services Code (UNSPSC) commodity codes for bid posting, identification of the goods and services provided by vendors, and vendor bid notification selections.

Also, vendors will begin to self-report new fields such as eVerify status and NC Secretary of State ID, and will move from reporting <u>Dun & Bradstreet DUNS number to the SAM.gov Unique Entity ID (UEI)</u> <u>identifier</u> in alignment with a recent shift by the U.S. federal government. Construction services vendors will be able to provide a licensed contact.

USER IMPACT

Buyers can take advantage of the newly added 6-digit level commodity codes and its benefits:



Enhanced commodity codes, along with the addition of new fields for vendors, will allow buyers to better identify vendors to meet their needs. Commodity code selection on solicitation postings will be

highlighted in a future update.

NEXT STEPS

Training materials and webinars on topics such as selecting commodity codes and searching for vendors will be available in the coming weeks before the new system goes live this summer.
