


### The New eVP Updates


### WHAT'S HAPPENING ...

A new electronic Vendor Portal (eVP) is underway and will include optimized functionality from eVP, IPS and NC BIDS. Among other improved features, the new eVP will include:

The project's go-live timeline has been slightly extended. To minimize impact on fiscal year-end processes, early FY24 is being targeted for the new eVP go-live date.
