Resolving Purchase Order Error Messages

If you receive a notification of a purchase order integration failure with the North Carolina Financial System (NCFS), be sure to check the reason for the failure. NCFS errors can be found in the comments section of a requisition. The <u>NCFS Error Message Summary</u> reference guide outlines the cause and resolution for most purchase order errors. If you receive a failure message and are not sure what it means, please contact the NC eProcurement Help Desk. The NC eProcurement Help Desk is now able to screenshare during phone calls using Rescue Live Guide.
