Resolving Purchase Order Error Messages

If you receive a notification of a purchase order integration failure with the North Carolina Financial System (NCFS), be sure to check the reason for the failure. NCFS errors can be found in the comments section of a requisition. The [NCFS Error Message Summary](#) reference guide outlines the cause and resolution for most purchase order errors. If you receive a failure message and are not sure what it means, please contact the NC eProcurement Help Desk at 888-211-7440.
