



SOURCING TIPS AND TRICKS: DOWNLOADING ATTACHMENTS

After the Sourcing Event reaches the response due date, the event status changes to 'Pending Selection.' Once the 'Envelopes' are opened, responses can be reviewed. On the 'Content' tab of the Event, the documents vendors have uploaded are available. The system can conveniently download all of the documents at the same time for review. To do this, click the 'Actions' drop-down menu in the top right corner and select 'Download All Supplier Attachments.'



On the 'Download Attachments' screen, certain vendors can be selected in the 'Select Participants' table. The documents to be downloaded are selected in the 'Selected Items' table as shown below. If all documents need to be downloaded, click the checkbox next to 'Title,' to quickly select all the items in the list. After all items have been selected, select 'Download Attachments' in the top right corner to download all attachments into a zip file.

TIPS AND TRICKS: COMMODITY CODES FOR SERVICES

The state of North Carolina uses the UNSPSC commodity code system which is a standardized system of numbers that categorizes items being purchased. When creating a non-catalog requisition, users must select a six-digit commodity code. This code can be found by searching through NC eProcurement or by using the <u>UNSPSC Commodity Code Search</u>.

UNSPSC commodity codes cover a wide range of goods and services. If you are purchasing something for the first time, it may take some time to identify the appropriate code. This is particularly true for service orders. Here are some common service codes with examples to help clarify when to use them:

721029 Facility maintenance and repair services (ex: asbestos treatment, floor cleaning)

761115 General building and office cleaning and maintenance services (ex: janitorial services)

761215 Refuse collection and disposal (ex: recycling or trash removal)

781018 Road cargo transport (ex: shipping and transportation of goods)

801315 Lease and rental of property or building (ex: modular units)

801618 Office equipment rental or leasing services (ex: copier leases)

811123 Computer hardware maintenance and support (ex: extended warranties)

811125 Software, computer, rental or lease (ex: any renewable software program or termed license)

831116 Mobile communications services (ex: cell phone service)

911018 Clothing rental (ex: uniform rentals)

Note: Service commodity codes usually start with a 7, 8 or 9.

STATEWIDE TERM CONTRACT ANNOUNCEMENT

Statewide Term Contract 1214A Gases: Medical, Welding & Specialty

NC DOA Purchase & Contract has established a new Statewide Term Contract 1214A Gases: Medical, Welding & Specialty that has replaced 430A. This is a multi-vendor mandatory statewide term contract for state agencies, departments, institutions, universities, and community colleges, unless exempted by North Carolina General Statute. Additionally, non-mandatory entities including schools and local governments that are allowed by North Carolina Statute may use this contract. The contract term is
