WHAT'S COMING UP...

The Department of Administration's (DOA) Division of Purchase & Contract (P&C), along with the NC eProcurement Team, is excited to announce an upgrade to the electronic Vendor Portal (eVP) and the Interactive Purchasing System (IPS).

WHAT THIS MEANS...



Currently, vendors register to do business with the state of North Carolina in eVP while IPS allows vendors to see and respond to posted bids opportunities.

The upgrade will merge functionality from eVP and IPS into a single, cloud-based application to optimize the way vendors do business with the state.

WHAT ARE THE NEW FEATURES...



Ability to respond to bid opportunities directly



Updated, online HUB and NCSBE certification processes



Enhanced vendor account management and public vendor search
