		digit codes they have currently selected. After go-live, vendors are encouraged to log in and review
		those commodity codes. Also, these commodity codes can be managed for individual contacts!(
		We will review the recertification process, but will not go into detail about qualifications for HUB vendors
		and the complete certification process.
