#### SOURCING TOOL ENHANCEMENTS

Recent enhancements have been made to the Sourcing tool:

#### The Sourcing Event:

- The sourcing event **'Description'** field has been updated to auto populate with language explaining to vendors the steps on how to respond to a solicitation, as well as information on where to go if they require additional assistance.
- Two additional attachments have been added to the sourcing event:
  - o 'Attachment H: Acknowledgment of Covid-19 Vaccination and Testing Policy'
  - o 'Certification for Federal Contracts, Grants, Loans and Cooperative Agreements'

#### The Solicitation Document:

• The solicitation document templates have been updated to reflect the new attachments that have been added to the sourcing event section.

#### Supporting Documents and 'Tasks' Tab:

• Updates and additions have been made to the templates in the 'Sourcing Project Documents' folder.

• Additional tasks have been added to the 'Tasks' tab on the sourcing project.

### **CREATING A FOLLOW-ON PROJECT FROM A SOURCING PROJECT**

After completing a sourcing project, users have the ability to transfer some of this information conveniently into a contract workspace, linking the workspace with the completed project. This type of contract workspace is called a **'Follow-on Project.'** To create a **'Follow-on Project,'** navigate to the **'Overview'** tab on the sourcing project and click **'Actions.'** From there, select the **'Follow-on Project'** option from the dropdown.

After the contract workspace has been created, links will appear on the **'Overview'** tabs of both the sourcing project and the contract workspace, named **'Follow-on Project'** and **'Predecessor Project'** respectively. These links will allow you to navigate quickly from the sourcing project to contract workspace.
